<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 12</p> <p><b>Was Ruth wrong to ask Boaz to marry her?</b></p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) no ... she asked him to marry her out of duty</li><li>2) Mosaic law said a relative had to marry a childless widow so husband's name would not disappear</li></ol>
