<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 13</p> <p><b>When was Samuel written?</b></p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<p>Originally = one book</p> <p>probably soon after the division of the kingdom</p> <p>author = unknown prophet</p>
<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 13</p> <p><b>Is the history in the Bible presented in a chronological order?</b></p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<p>no</p> <p>similar events were grouped together to make the lessons of these events clear</p>

<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 13</p> <p><b>When did the events of 1 Samuel 1-8 occur?</b></p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<p>some disagreement</p> <p>most hold occurred around same time as Judges 10-16</p> <p>Eli = Shiloh priest</p> <p>Jephthah = judging eastern tribes</p> <p>Samson = warring against Philistines</p>
<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 13</p> <p><b>Compare Samson and Samuel</b></p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<p>both Nazarites for life</p> <p>Samson = God demanded it</p> <p>Samuel = voluntary (from heart)</p> <p>Samuel = delivered Israel from Philistine oppression &amp; sin (not Samson)</p>

<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 13</p> <p><b>How does Israel lose the ark?</b></p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) Eli's son use it as a good luck charm and take it into battle</li><li>2) Philistines capture ark &amp; Israel is defeated</li><li>3) ark causes a lot of trouble to the Philistines &amp; they send it back</li></ol>
