<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 15</p> <p><b>What promise did God give David?</b></p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<p>David's house will last forever (Christians)</p> <p>the Son of David is Christ, the Third Person in the Trinity</p>

<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 15</p> <p><b>How did Nathan confront David's sin?</b></p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<p>Nathan tells David of a legal concern needing judgment (parable). Nathan does not mention names, but gives the title of "rich man" &amp; "poor man." David could see the injustice &amp; rendered his decision immediately. Then, Nathan told David the "rich man" was him.</p>
