<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 17</p> <p>Name the authors of the Psalms.</p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<p>David wrote 73 psalms Asaph, David's choir director wrote 12 psalms sons of Korah wrote 11 psalms Solomon wrote 2 psalms Moses wrote 1 psalm Ethan wrote 1 psalm 50 psalms are anonymous</p>
<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 17</p> <p>How is the Psalter divided?</p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<p>divided into 5 books to correspond with the Pentateuch — or Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy</p> <p>it can also be divided like the Heidelberg Catechism — sin, salvation & gratitude</p>
