<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 32</p> <p>What five teachings are presented in the “Servant” passage?</p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Servant will bring salvation to all nations & will be exalted (Isa 52:13-25)2) Servant rejected; no beauty in Him (Isa 53:1-3)3) Servant is a substitute bearing our sin & buying our salvation (Isa 53:4-6)4) Servant provides substitutionary death (Isa 53:5-9)5) Servant’s sufferings justify His people (Isa 53:10-12)
<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 32</p> <p>What will happen to the nation?</p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) it will be destroyed2) the true Israel, the ancient Church, (those who truly love God) within the nation will be spared and blessed
<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 32</p> <p>What will the Servant do?</p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) open the Church doors to all2) no more distinction between Jew & Gentile<ul style="list-style-type: none">— all who love God (Jew/Gentile) = blessed— all who disobey God (Jew/Gentile) = punishment
