<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 33</p> <p><b>Tell about the author of Micah.</b></p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<p>author = Micah the name Micah means "Who is like God?"</p> <p>from Moresheth-gath (village 20 miles SW of Jerusalem)</p> <p>prophesied in Judah under reigns of Jotham, Ahaz, and Hezekiah</p> <p>contemporary of Isaiah</p>
<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 33</p> <p><b>What do the three sections of Micah emphasize?</b></p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<p>Micah is in three parts beginning with the word "Hear" (Micah 1:2; 3:1; 6:1)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) judgment</li><li>2) blessings in the "latter days"</li><li>3) call to repentance</li></ol>

<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 33</p> <p><b>What is the best known prophecy from Micah?</b></p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<p>Micah 5:2 — prophecy of Christ’s birthplace</p> <p>“But thou Bethlehem Ephrathah, which art little to be among the thousands of Judah, out of thee shall come One forth unto Me that is to be Ruler in Israel: whose goings forth are from old, from everlasting”</p> <p>reveals Christ is human and divine</p>
<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 33</p> <p><b>Beside uncovering sin what does God do?</b></p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<p>offers mercy if the call of repentance is heeded</p> <p>“He hath showed thee, O man, what is good; and what doth Jehovah require of thee, but to do justly, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with thy God?” Micah 6:8</p>
<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 33</p> <p><b>What is the purpose of Micah?</b></p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) show God’s anger at Israel’s &amp; Judah’s sin</li><li>2) warn of judgment because of sin</li><li>3) point beyond judgment to salvation God will provide in His Messiah</li></ol>
