What does it mean?</p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<p>prophecy accompanies visions</p> <p>High Priest Joshua crowned = explained as a prophecy of the Messiah</p> <p>... shall build the temple of Jehovah; and He shall bear the glory, and shall sit and rule upon His throne; and He shall be a priest upon His throne; and the counsel of peace shall be between them both (Zechariah 6:13)</p>
