<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 6</p> <p><b>What other names does the tabernacle have?</b></p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) <i>dwelling place</i> - shows God dwells among His people</li><li>2) <i>tent of meeting</i> - shows God meets with His people and fellowships with them</li><li>3) <i>tent of testimony</i> - constantly testifies to God's covenant with His people</li><li>4) <i>holy place</i> - set part because God is present, to be viewed with awe</li></ol>

<p>Kingdom of God Chapter 6</p> <p><b>How is the tabernacle a type of Christ?</b></p> <p>© Beverly Schmitt, all rights reserved</p>	<p>tabernacle = divinely appointed place where God dwelt with His people and fellowship with them</p> <p>Christ took the form of man and dwelt with us. After He ascended into heaven, the Holy Spirit was sent to dwell with His people</p> <p>John 1:14 "and the Word became flesh and tabernacled among us"</p>
