Redeeming the Time: Christian concept which, basically, means to convert something into value, to recover, to not waste time or material.

Contract Definition: To draw together. To shrink or shorten.

Contraction Definition: Pulling together two words dropping one letter or some letters substituting an apostrophe (a comma that hangs in the air) for the missing letters

Week #1:

We will begin by contracting a verb with the adverb *not*.

<u>Verb</u>	+	<u>Adverb</u>	=	<u>Contraction</u>
do	+	not	=	don't
does	+	not	=	doesn't
did	+	not	=	didn't
has	+	not	=	hasn't
have	+	not	=	haven't
had	+	not	=	hadn't
is	+	not	=	isn't
