Week #5:

We will continue to contract pronouns (i.e., they, it, us, who, what) with a verb along with adverbs (i.e., where, there, here) with a verb. (Note: let is a verb in this situation.)

<u>Pronoun</u>	+	<u>Verb</u>	=	<u>Contraction</u>
-----------------------	----------	--------------------	----------	---------------------------

they	+	have	=	they've
they	+	are	=	they're

<u>Adverb</u>	+	<u>Verb</u>	=	<u>Contraction</u>
----------------------	----------	--------------------	----------	---------------------------

where	+	is	=	where's
there	+	is	=	there's
here	+	is	=	here's
