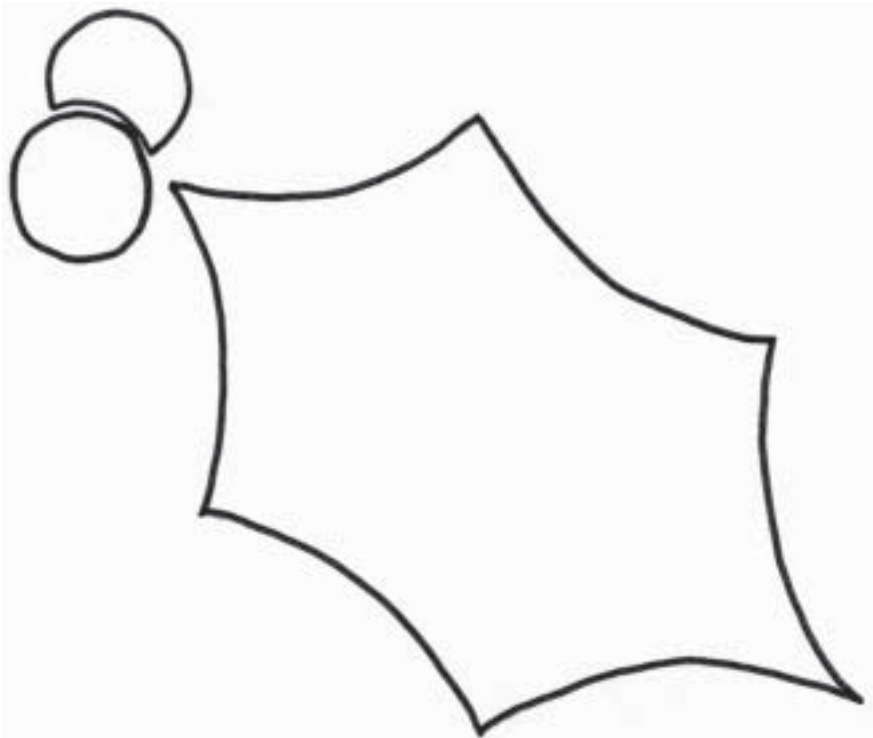


Make Your Own Christmas Wreath!

Beloved — variety of hearts (Ephesians 1:6; Matthew 12:18; Mark 1:11)
Branch — twigs, small branch (Zechariah 3:8; Jeremiah 23:5; Jeremiah 33:15; Isaiah 11:1)
Bread of Life — homemade clay bread loaf (John 6:35; John 6:41; John 6:51)
Bright Morning Star — star shaped ornament (Revelation 22:16)
Captain of Salvation — small sailing ship (Hebrews 2:10)
Carpenter's Son — saw (Matthew 13:55)
Diadem — crown, tiara (Isaiah 28:5)
Door — key (John 10:9)
First Fruits — any fruit (1 Corinthians 15:23)
Immanuel — manger (Matthew 1:23)
Judge — gavel ((Micah 5:1; Acts 10:42)
King — crown, thrown (1 Timothy 1:17; Psalm 24:7; John 12:13; Matthew 27:37;
Zechariah 9:9; Zechariah 14:9)
King of Kings — crown (I Timothy 6:15-16)
Lamb of God — homemade sheep made from cotton balls (John 1:29)
Light of the World — lightbulb, small flashlight, birthdaycandle (John 1:9; John 8:12;
Acts 13:47; John 9:5)
Lily of the Valley — small lily (Song of Solomon 2:1)
Lion of the Tribe of Judah — small lion (Revelation 5:5)
Living Water - John 4:10 - small pitcher
Mediator — judge (Hebrews 12:24)
Our Peace — dove (Ephesians 2:14)
Physician — small, toy doctor's bag (Luke 4:23)
Potter — homemade clay pot (Isaiah 64:8)
Prince of Peace — small dove (Isaiah 9:6)
Promised One — rainbow (Acts 13:23)
Shepherd — candy cane (John 10:11; 1 Peter 2:25)
Resurrection — variety of crosses (John 11:25-26)
Righteous Judge — gavel (2 Timothy 4:8)
Rock — small balloon painted like a rock or a pebble (Psalm 95:1)
Rose of Sharon — rose (Song of Solomon 2:)
Savior — variety of crosses (I John 4:14)
Star out of Jacob — cardboard star (Numbers 24:17)
Strength and Shield — cardboard shield/ sword (Psalm 28:7)
Son of Righteousness — golden orb or gavel (Malachi 4:2)
True Vine — grapes (John 15:5)
Way — minature road map / atlas / globe (John 14:6)
Word — Bible (John 1:14; 1 John 1:1; Revelation 19:13)

- Angels (to show they heralded His coming)
- Bells (to proclaim His birth)
- Carolers (to join with the angels praising Him)

- Horns (to herald His birth)
